Recognition Certificate for the school under sub-rule (4) of rule 11 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 for the purpose of section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

Dear Sir/Madam.

With reference to your application and subsequent correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I convey the grant of provisional recognition to the SMD World School for class 1st to class 8th for a period of three year w.e.f. 1.4.2019 to 31.3.2022.

The above sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions, namely:

- 1. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any imply any obligation to recognize/affiliate beyond Class VIII.
- 2. The school shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure-I) and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure-II).
- 3. The school shall admit in class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to the weaker section and the disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide Free and Compulsory Elementary Education till its completion:

Provided, that in case of Pre-primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.

- 4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per subsection 2 of section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursement, the school shall provide a separate bank account.
- 5. The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any Screening Procedure.
- 6. The school shall not deny admission -
  - (a) to any child for lack of age proof; or
  - if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed period (b) prescribed for admission; or
  - (c) on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of these reasons.
- 7. The school shall ensure that -
  - (a) no child admitted, shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school;

no child shall be subjected to physical punishment or, mental harassment; (b)

- (c) no child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education:
- every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid downwood (d) under rule 21;

inclusion of students with disabilities/special needs as per the provisions of the Act: (e) the teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications, as laid under sub-section (1) of ation (f) section 23; provided that the existing teachers who, at the time of commencement of the

Act, do not possess the minimum qualifications, shall acquire such qualifications with in Sant Ram a period of S years from the date of commencement of the Act.

- the teachers shall not engage himself or herself in any private teaching activities. (h)
- The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate 8. authority.
- The school shall enroll students proportionate to the norms and standards available in the 9. school as specified in section 19 of the Act.
- The school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 10. of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection, if made, are as given under:-

- No un-recognized classes shall be run within the premises of the school or outside of the 11. premises in the same name of school.
- The school buildings or other structures or the grounds shall be used only for the purpose 12. of education and skill development.
- 13. The school is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (Act No.21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
- The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or 14. any other persons.
- The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper 15. accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the statements of accounts should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.
- 16. The recognition code number allotted to your school is SSA-RTE 3 192 (This may please be noted and quoted for any future correspondence with this office).
- 17. The school furnishes such reports and information, as may be required by the Director or District Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Government/Local Authority, as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.

#### VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the letter dated 09.01.2023 (Annexure P-10) with a further prayer for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to issue permanent recognition orders to the members of the petitioner/Federation in terms of the provisions of The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (hereinafter referred to as "RTE Act 2009") and the Rules framed thereunder.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the Indian Parliament had framed the Right of Education to Free and Compulsory Education Rules 2010 in terms of the RTE Act 2009 and Rule 15 and Rule 16 specifically deal with the procedure for recognition and withdrawal of Vrecognition, respectively and a cumulative reading of the said two Rules

would show that there is no provision for grant of a yearly/tenure recognition and in the said rules, there is only a one time recognition unless it is withdrawn under Rule 16 of 2010 Rules. It is further submitted that the State of Punjab, in terms of Section 38 of the RTE Act, has promulgated The Punjab Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 and Rule 11 and 12 of the same are in pari materia with Rules 15 and 16 of the 2010 Rules framed by the Union of India. It is stated that the action of the authorities in granting recognition under the RTE Act / RTE Rules on a yearly / tenure / provisional basis, is, de hors the provisions of the Rules. It is further stated that the issue at hand is squarely covered by a judgment of a Coordinate Bench of this court in CWP no.12389 of 2021 titled as "Ameliorating India, NGO vs. State of Punjab and others" decided on 02.11.2021 (Annexure P-8) and has submitted that inspite of the said judgment, instructions are being issued again for grant of provisional recognition. It is submitted that as per the latest correspondence between the District Education Officer, Ludhiana dated 14.03.2023 and the Director Public Instructions (E.E.), Punjab, SAS Nagar, request has been made by the concerned authority to guide the authorities in terms of the judgment passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court. It is further submitted that for the grievances raised by the petitioner, the petitioner has given a representation dated 12.01,2023 and at this stage, he would be satisfied in case the Secretary, Department of School Education, takes a final decision on the said representation in a time bound manner. It is prayed that while adjudicating the same, the judgment of coordinate Bench (Annexure P-8), against which no LPA has been filed, be also taken into consideration.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the matter is under consideration and a final decision on the said aspect would be taken by the
