3. The Science Laboratories were upgraded with modern apparatus and advanced equipment to encourage experiential learning and strengthen practical understanding among students.

The school library was enriched with a comprehensive collection of over 5000 books, along with regular subscriptions to leading newspapers, magazines, and research journals, making it a vibrant centre of knowledge and inquiry for both students and teachers.
